Guiding the Assistant Director of Foundation Relations and outside grant writers involved in pipeline building, the Senior Director ensures active portfolio management, cultivating, soliciting and stewarding foundation funders for maximum engagement and philanthropic investment.

Desired Qualifications: The ideal candidate is an accomplished relationship manager with progressively increasing achievement in securing foundation support; an engaging, entrepreneurial and highly motivated leader with superb communications, negotiating and organizational skills, high integrity and professional judgement; a person of enthusiasm and initiative who works effectively with diverse constituencies.
